Collect and publicize facts and other information on the current North Korean human rights situation, particularly regarding political prison camps.

–

Propose to international organizations to prosecute and condemn the North Korean human rights situation, particularly with respect to the forced labor of political prisoners.

–

Protect the lives and human rights of North Korean refugees.

–

Assist North Korean defectors living in South Korea, focusing on youth education.

–

Coordinate efforts with other human rights organizations to fulfill the programs mentioned above.
